1. A Bachelor's degree comprises 128 credits. It depends on Recognized Prior Learning how many of these 128 credits are actually necessary.
2. Core modules (i.e., compulsory courses) are displayed in bold. Some might be more relevant in certain contexts than in others. The Chief Academic Officer and Registrar reserve the right to determine, which courses are compulsory, as they see fit.
3. The other modules will be chosen by the Chief Academic Officer/Registrar and allocated mentor in conjunction with the student in light of his/her ministry calling and gifts.

4. The Bachelor's degree also includes a practical project (4 credits) and a 15,000-word dissertation (8 credits).
5. All students will be enrolled in NEO, our LMS. Every module contains module descriptors, free PDF literature, a study guide (if appropriate), lectures/videos, at least one quiz, and the student feedback form that needs to be returned at the end of the module.
6. NCIU recognizes that not all students striving towards a Bachelor's degree might be in a position to bring it to fruition. NCIU therefore offers three types of diplomas for students who have completed Bachelor level modules and satisfied all academic requirements and financial obligations. Bachelor's degree fees apply.
