3. The other modules will be chosen by the Chief Academic Officer and allocated mentor in conjunction with the student in light of his/her ministry calling and gifts.
4. The Bachelor degree also includes a practical project (4 credits) and 60-page dissertation (8 credits).
5. *Workload per module:* Core reading and a 2,000-word essay.
6. At the end of each completed module, students are required to return a filled in feedback form to the tutor.
