2. Core modules (i.e. compulsory courses) are displayed in bold.
3. The other modules will be chosen by the Chief Academic Officer and allocated mentor in conjunction with the student in light of his/her ministry calling and gifts.
4. The Master degree also includes a practical project (4 credits) and 100-page dissertation (16 credits).
5. *Workload per module:* Core reading and a 3,000-word essay.
6. At the end of each completed module, students are required to return a filled in feedback form to the tutor.
